- Does their company participate in any HVAC industry associations, committees or societies?
- Are their technicians licensed and certified?
- Does their company specialize in any specific industries or building types?
- Can they provide a copy of the maintenance agreement?
- Are there any additional costs/charges for service calls?
- What is the response time for emergencies?
- Will they provide written reports and recommendations for repair or service?
